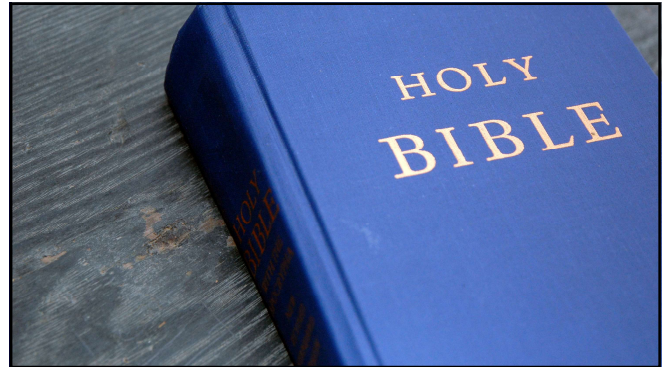
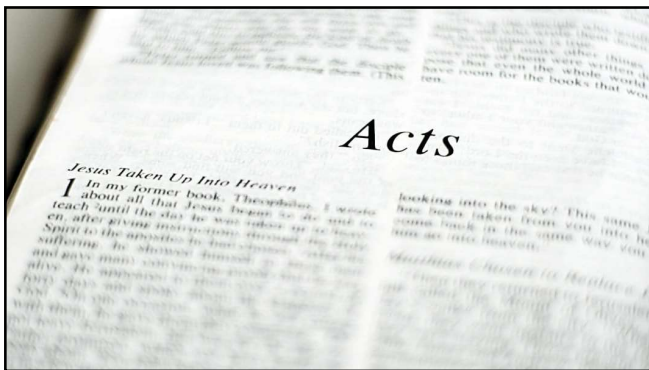


Sermon
