

Tuesday Evening Sermon at Brightons Parish Church
Digging Deeper with God – Tuesday 23rd June 2020

Further reflections on tonight's sermon for personal, group or family devotion. Read the Scriptures again slowly in a quiet space and notice which verse(s) God is especially highlighting to you:

Psalm 148

Write the verse down and invite God in prayer to tell you why this verse is significant to you. Remember God speaks today!

Here are some questions to think through in addition to what might have struck you already:

- What do you make of the triangle example in Jesus' life?
- UP – what have you found helpful recently in allowing "God to be God"? Where is God seeking to grow this way of life in you at present?
- OUT – do we struggle to see "creation care" as part of "mission"? How have you (or could you) put creation care on your agenda?
- OUT – sharing your faith: what have you found helpful in this?
- IN – what have you found helpful as ways of allowing others to speak into your life and encourage/challenge your faith?
- IN – how conscious are you of being "close to [God's] heart"? What has your experience of God been like of late?
- Spend a little time talking to God in prayer. Here's something to get you started or to round off your time:

My God and heavenly Father, I join with all creation in giving
You the worship, honour and praise due to Your name alone!
I think You are wonderful because... *(name something)*

I thank You for sending Jesus to die for me and
I take a moment to confess any known sin to You... *(name them)*

O my God, give me Your Spirit that I might put tonight's message in
practice, in particular the issue around... *(name a key point for you)*

Heavenly Father, I also bring before You the concerns that are most
upon my heart tonight... *(name them)*

Hear my prayer, Lord God, for I ask this in Jesus' name, Amen.
