### Falkirk Foodbank

Demand on Falkirk Foodbank will have been very high over the past few weeks. If you are able to assist with replenishing stocks then, typically, they need:

- Tinned meat - mince, stew, casseroles etc

- Tinned fruit
- Tins or packets of potatoes
- Cartons of long-life juice.
- Bottles of diluting juice
- Desserts - packets of jellies to make up, steamed puddings, packets of trifle to make up, Angel Delight etc.
- Adult toothbrushes (as you know dentists are hardly open and they are only giving children's toothbrushes)
- Tampons
