




Message

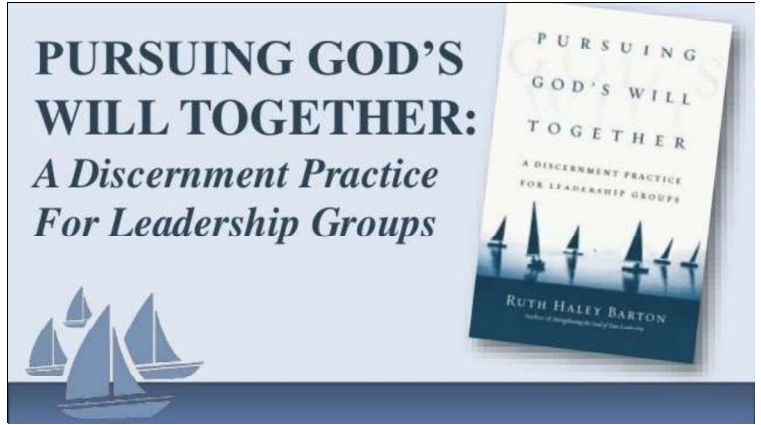
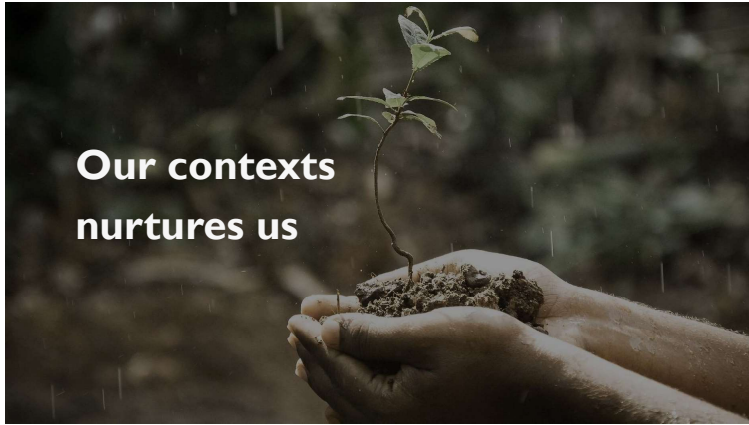
